TOWNWIDE SPELLING BEE - Information and Rules

1. Participants must be students in grades 3 through 6 currently attending Newington Schools or students who are Newington residents. Students can only participate in the Bee for their current grade level.
2. Preregistration is required! Only fully completed registrations received between 2/7/2011 and 2/28/2011 via US Postal Service mail at the indicated address will be considered. Space is limited -- only 45 contestant slots are available per bee. Contestant slots will be filled based on a "first come, first served" basis, so mail completed registration forms today! REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED. If confirmation of registration is desired, contact Meri @ danmeri@sbcglobal.net.
3. A contestant should arrive at least 20 minutes before his/her Grade Level Competition is scheduled to begin. Contestant must confirm registration at Check-in Table in Town Hall Lobby to compete. Late arrivals will not be allowed to participate once Grade Level Competition has begun and first round has been completed.
4. Seating for spectators is available in the Council Chambers Auditorium. Spectators are to remain in their seats and remain silent during Grade Level Competition. Spectators not honoring these rules will be asked to leave the Auditorium. Spectators shall not provide assistance to contestants with facial expressions, nods, body language, etc. If this occurs, spectator will be asked to leave the Auditorium and the contestant may be eliminated from the Bee.
5. NCTV Ch. 14 will film the Townwide Spelling Bee for broadcast. Other media representatives may also be present. Permission to participate in the Bee also grants permission for contestants' possible broadcast or print appearance.
6. For the first phase of the competition, the Word Announcer will pronounce the word, use it in sentence, and pronounce the word again. Contestant must pronounce the word, spell the word and pronounce the word again. The contestant is not finished until he/she says the word a second time. A contestant may not change the spelling of the word after he/she pronounces it for the second time. However, the contestant may change the spelling of the word before he/she pronounces it for the second time. The contestant must retrace the spelling from the beginning.
7. The first phase of the Spelling Bee is based on single elimination. Upon missing the spelling of the word, contestant is immediately eliminated from the competition. When only 2 contestants remain, the elimination procedure changes. Details will be provided at the Bee.
8. The Judges are in complete control of the Spelling Bee. Judges' decision shall be final.
